Independence From Oil

I'd like to thank the EV owners from around the region who have made a deliberate choice to get away from gasoline to reduce the demand for oil, improve air quality, create local jobs, and avoid being dependent on other distant lands. While you may have picked an EV because they are more fun to drive, your choice is helping the local economy, strengthening national security, and improving our air quality.

The region around Sacramento has over 58,000 Electric Cars. Together each year we:

- Save about 25,000,000 gallons of gas
- Eliminate over 4,600 gas tanker truck loads of fuel
- Avoid over 1,200 oil tanker cars on the tracks
- Save consuming nearly 327,000,000 gallons of water (from oil refining)
- Save ~\$113,000,000 in fuel purchases

For Independence Day, I'd like to make two requests:

1. Take a minute to reflect on how far we have come since 2010 and congratulate yourselves for helping us achieve that.
2. Share Oil Independence Day with friends and neighbors (a ride here, a mention there, etc.)

More than 80 models of electric cars are on the market and we've built a strong used EV market. New or used, they're fun to drive and driving electric is both practical and patriotic!


