## Second-Life Electric Vehicle Batteries

Batteries are the most expensive EV component. At the end of their service life in EVs, retired batteries may retain 70-80% of their initial capacity. Recycling is necessary in the end, but before that, retired but still-capable batteries can have a second life in less-demanding applications like stationary energy storage.
