Electric Pickup Trucks in Veloz Webinar





SacEV's Guy Hall is forecasting over 50,000 EVs will have been sold in the Sacramento Region by the end of 2021. In addition, 552 DC fast chargers, (531 public, and 21 shared private) will be available in approximately 100 charging plazas.

For model year 2021, 54 plug-in electric vehicle models were available to consumers. Small sport utility vehicles led the way (14), followed by midsize cars (10), standard SUVs (8), and others. The number of models in each vehicle class is growing, and plug-in pickup trucks will be added to the list in

the near future.

Sacramento International Airport Is Awarded 18 ZEV Shuttle Buses



The Federal Aviation Administration has awarded the Sacramento International Airport \$4.6M to purchase ZEV shuttle buses and charging stations. By mid-year 2022, 18 ZEV buses will be operating at the airport, with all 35 shuttle buses due to be ZEVs within several years. You can read more [here](#).

Massive Oil Spill Off Huntington Beach




A large oil spill off the southern California coast has left fish dead, birds mired in petroleum, and wetlands contaminated, prompting local officials to call it an environmental catastrophe. The size of the oil spill has been reduced, but it still is estimated at 25,000 gallons by the US Coast Guard.
