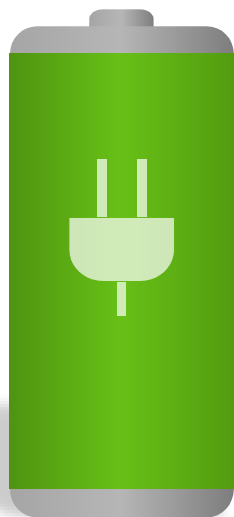




ATTENTION
MONTHLY ELECTRIC VEHICLE PERMIT CUSTOMERS
EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2018



City Council Resolution (Amendment) 2000-646 establishes the City's Electric Vehicle (EV) Parking Program, with criteria to provide free or discounted EV parking. Monthly EV parking transactions at **Tower Bridge Garage** and **Old Sacramento Garage** now exceed the program threshold to maintain free EV parking access. EV permits will now be available at 50% of the regular monthly rate.

All **Limited EV Access** monthly cardholders have until **January 26, 2018** to convert their parking access to Tower Bridge Garage EV at a rate of \$65 per month, Old Sacramento Garage EV at a rate of \$57.50 per month or Memorial Garage EV at a rate of \$67.50 per month. There is currently a waiting list for monthly EV parking at Capitol Garage and City Hall Garage.

You will **not** need to visit our office to re-program your card.

Failure to respond may result in the deactivation of your parking access card.

WHAT TO DO:

Go to www.sacpark.org:

- Click on Forms & Applications from the side menu.
- Click on Electric Vehicle Parking Application.
- Complete entire application, making sure to indicate whether you are selecting Tower Bridge Garage, Old Sacramento Garage, or Memorial Garage.
- **You do not need to re-submit your DMV registration unless it will expire soon.**
- You may enroll in AutoPay by submitting a Credit Card Authorization Form. Download the credit card authorization form from the Forms & Application page, fill out and fax in the form to begin automatic payments and receive an emailed receipt each month. **Please do not email credit card authorization forms.**
- If you prefer to pay in person each month, you may do so at the Revenue Office, or you may submit your payment to the mailing address below.
- **Payments must be received by the first of each month in order to prevent service interruption.**
