

SacEV opposes AB 2806 - Disabled Placards & On-Street Charging

[AB2806](#) would grant access to any vehicle with a disabled placards and a lift or ramp to park in on-street EV spaces without charging.

This is being reviewed by Senate Transportation and Housing Committee. SacEV's concerns are:

- Allowing any non-EV parking at these spots is counter to the goals of the state (as expressed in policy by the Governor, the Legislature, the Energy Commission, and the CPUC), as well as the region.
- As it is, there are not enough public charging spaces, and EV drivers depend on being able to find charging.
- We are very sympathetic to the needs of members of the disabled community, and if there is a lack of available parking for vans and cars with lift systems, that problem should absolutely be addressed.

We just don't believe this bill is the correct solution to the problem it is attempting to solve.
