Charger Ribbon Cutting at Muir Commons - This Wednesday

Please join us from 4:00 - 5:30 pm in the parking lot of Muir Commons on Wednesday November 14, in the southwest portion of the parking lot next to the workshop, where we will celebrate and "cut the ribbon" on a charger for each of our community's 26 households.

The installation provides Level-2 charging to Muir Commons residents through an electronic management system that tracks usage, generates monthly billing and controls access. The chargers are owned and maintained by Pacific Gas & Electric, and will deliver power from the Valley Clean Energy Alliance.

This installation would not have been possible without your collective support and our community would like to thank you and show you our appreciation. We plan to have light refreshments available as well as a brief program from 5:15-5:45, including a ribbon cutting ceremony.
