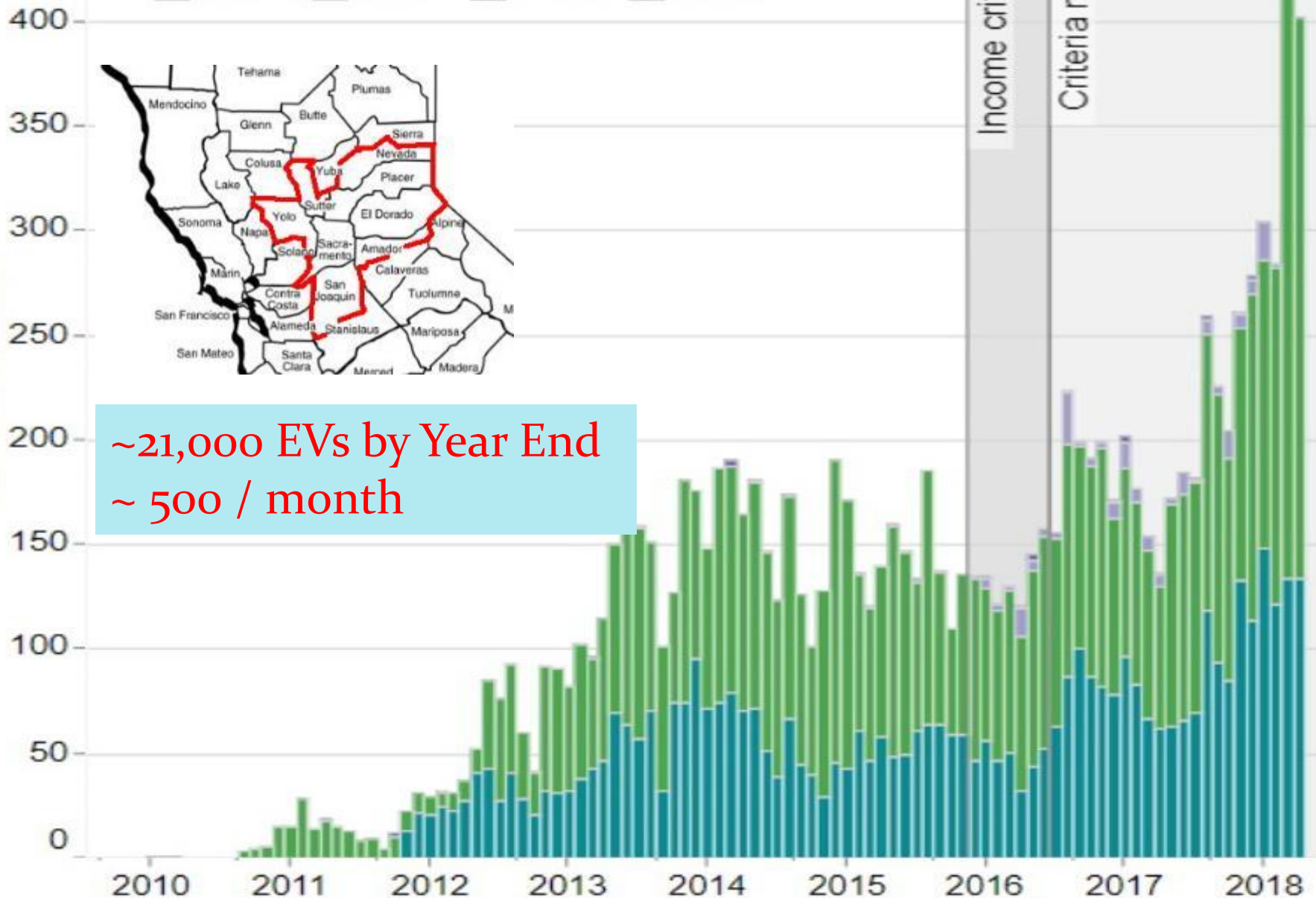
CVRP Rebates by Month

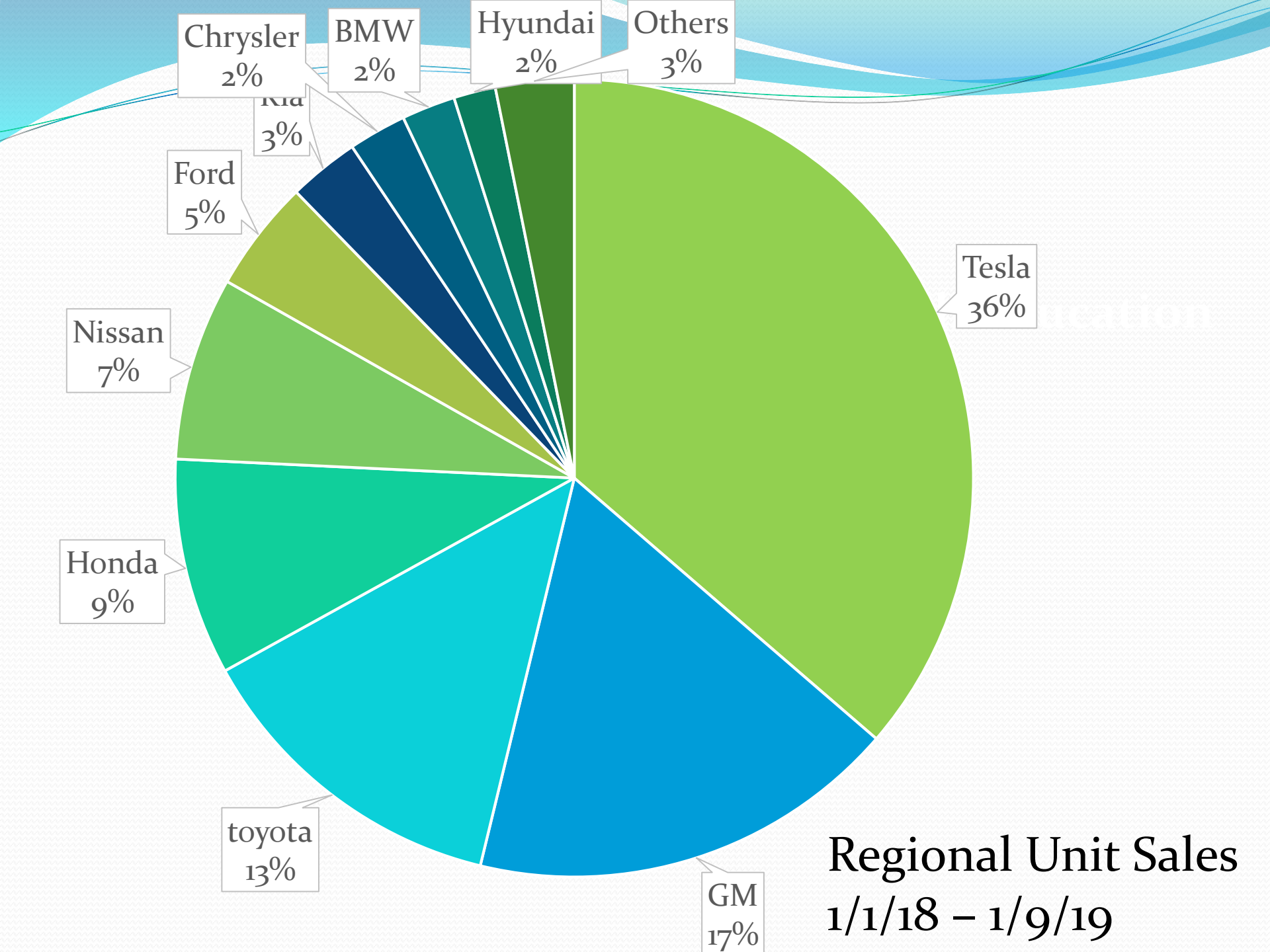

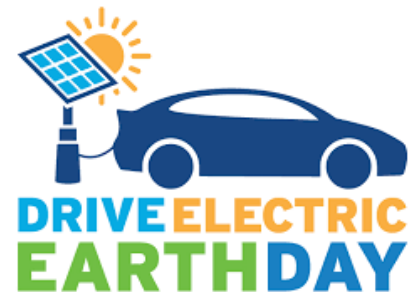
